ORDER DECLARING JUDICIAL EMERGENCY

COMES NOW the undersigned Chief Judge of Superior Courts for the Atlantic Judicial Circuit and declares the existence of a judicial emergency affecting all of the courts in this circuit. This emergency is due to Hurricane Dorian traveling through Georgia and causing the courts to close due to inclement weather which would imperil employees of the courts and members of the public who might be required to travel to court facilities. This emergency declaration is based on the recommendation of the County Manager and the County Emergency Management Agency. The duration of the judicial emergency shall be for September 3, 2019, through September 6, 2019.

Pursuant to OCGA Section 38-3-62, the undersigned suspends, tolls, extends and otherwise grants relief from all deadlines, time schedules and filing requirements as shown in subsections 1-11 of said code section.
